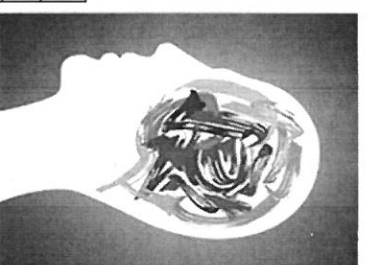


Sensory Workshop

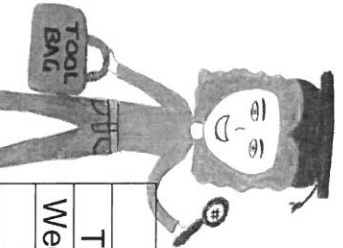
The session has been developed by the Learning Disability / Complex Needs service and mirrors the approaches used in sensory preference assessments.
