This year our Sixth Formers enjoyed a celebratory leavers ball at Poulton Cricket Club.



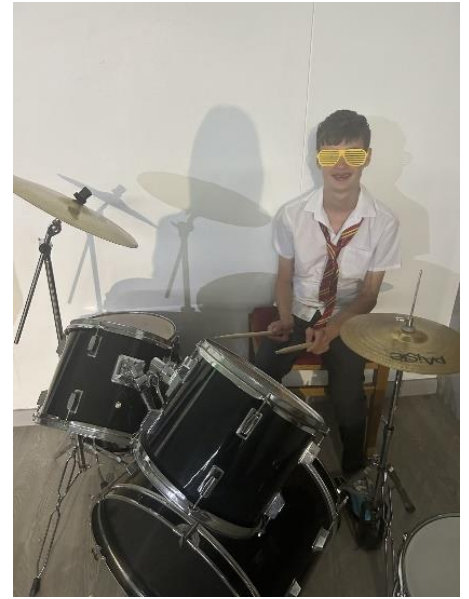
Science Week is part of our inclusive enrichment programme, helping our pupils to develop their scientific knowledge and skills. What a fantastic week we had!
