Children from Violet Class learnt about foods we eat at home with our family.



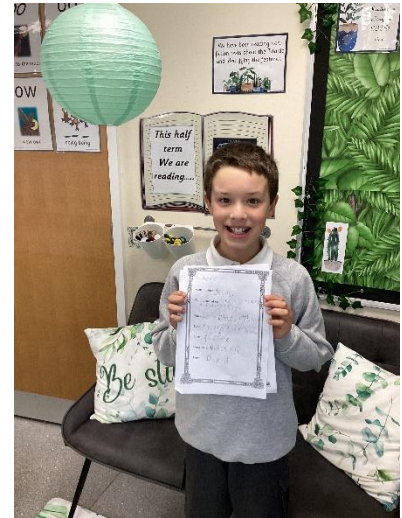
Pupils in Blossom Class learnt about food from hot and cold countries.



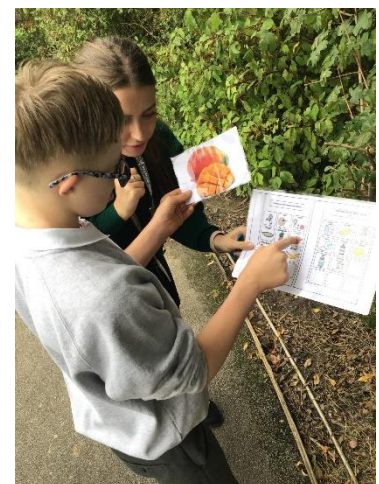
Pupils in Sycamore class learnt about the different foods we harvest in Autumn. They harvested, washed, chopped and peeled vegetables and fruit.
