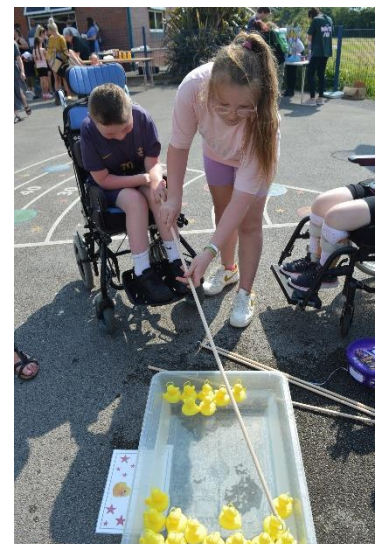
Well done to our Senior and Sixth Form students for their amazing performances in 'Breaking Boundaries'. You were all fantastic!
