




Our Early Years and Lower Primary pupils had a wonderful time participating in a festive art workshop led by Tigerlilies Creative Play.







We were very proud this term when our Sixth Form and senior students performed at the Winter Gardens in front of a huge audience.








We were awarded the "Louise Brunskill Award for Performing Excellence" Look at our wonderful trophy.
